Entering School

Use signs, decals and flags to remind students and staff the things they can do to provide a safe learning zone.

- 1 Seat Decals**
Remind students to space out as much as possible on the bus with seat decals.
- 2 Ground Decals**
Ground decals are a simple-but-efficient way to direct traffic and encourage social distancing.
- 3 A-Frame Signs**
Durable and useful indoors and out, A-frame signs can be placed wherever needed.
- 4 Single-Sided Feather Flags**
Feather flags use color and movement to grab attention, making them especially effective for communicating important information.
- 5 Window Decals**
A high-visibility way to share information, wall and window decals can be used to announce information as students and staff enter the school.
- 6 Durable Banners**
Banners offer an eye-catching, weather-resistant way to help parents and students navigate their way in the door.



Office

Safeguard the health of all who enter. Use partitions to protect your staff, apply decals to encourage social distancing, and incorporate single-use products into your operation.

① Hand Sanitizer Stations

A hand sanitizer station is a great way to make sure those entering the office are safe and healthy.

② Table Tents

Table tents are a cost-effective tool for communicating messages to those entering an office.

③ Floor Decals

Portable counter-top barriers are the first line of protection for your staff, students and visitors.

⑤ Retractable Banner Stands

Large and easy to read, banners communicate effectively but use minimal floor space.



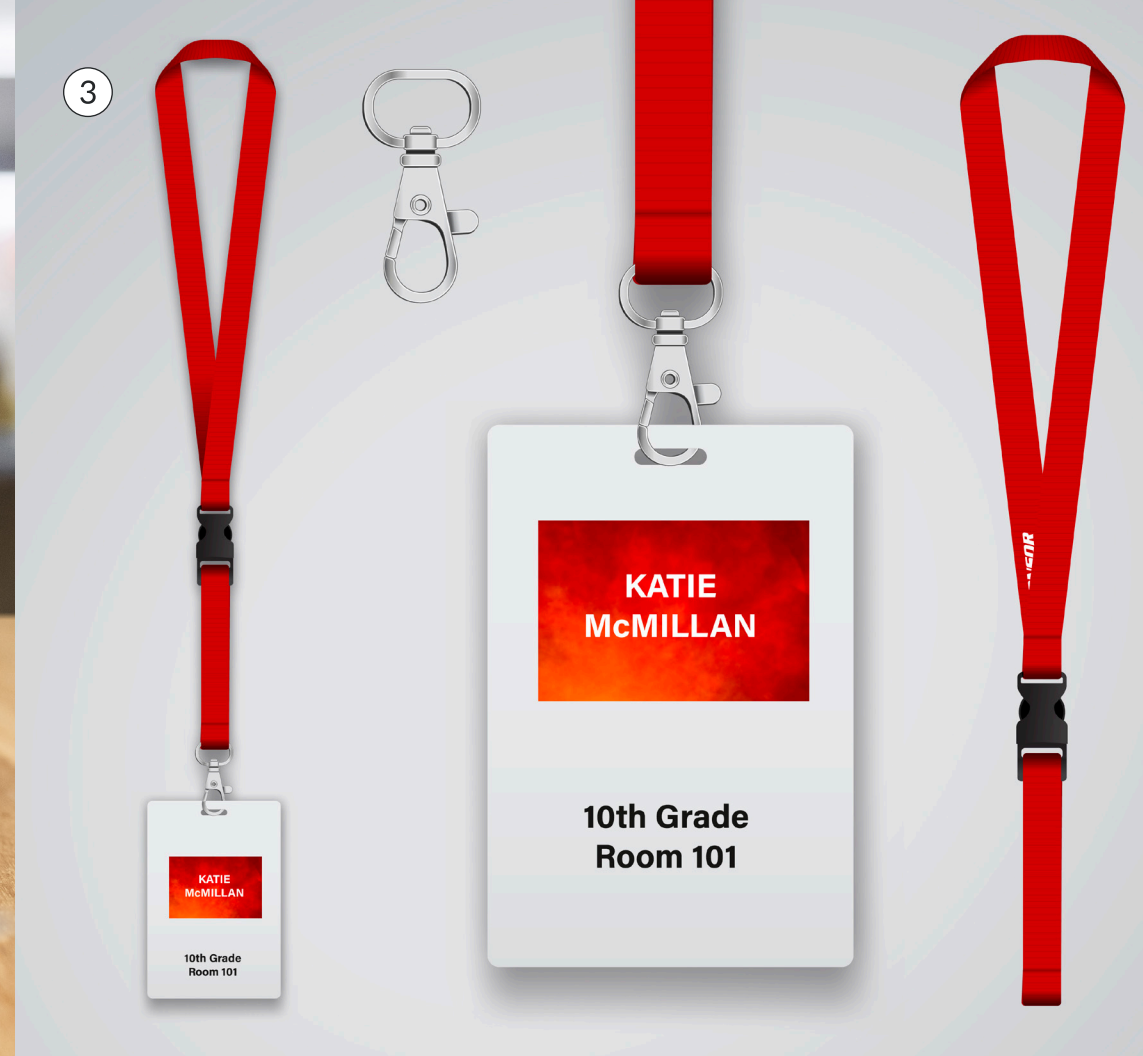
Gym (Activities)

More Solutions

- ① **Direct Mail**
Explain health and safety procedures and e-learning plans via direct mail pieces.
- ② **Drinkware**
Avoid students drinking from the wrong bottle and keep them hydrated with personalized drinkware.
- ③ **Lanyards**
Communicate students names clearly and provide homeroom information with lanyards that hold ID cards.
